At a meeting of the Supporters Club Committee on Tuesday 15th January 1991, there was a discussion on the lack of improvement of the Lee Valley Lions and the drop in the numbers of fans and lack of interest. This meant a loss of revenue for fund raising and the shop, thus enabling us to only pay £1,300 cash to the team this season. There were also sums of £450 for players and incidentals and a free coach which we ran to Basingstoke to try to get more away support, but this failed dismally as fans did not want to go and see a losing team! Even if they did not have to pay the fare. To keep the interest of supporters this season has been a struggle but we need to be shown some dedication and confidence by team and management as the supporters have shown them in the past, there are people in the supporters club that have listened and dug deep into their hard earned cash many a time without hesitation and by now it is about time they started to get a return of some sort for their money. The committee decided with a unanimous vote no more actual cash sponsorship until improvement in the team, therefore in club's revenue. I thought after the meeting that this being such an important matter that I would call a full members meeting on the 23-1-91. It was very well attended - sixty seven members in all, the result of the committee meeting was told to members and a discussion took place. It was decided by vote to stick by the committee decision and keep all monies earned by the supporters club apart from running bills. I told the supporters of the release of Rob Morris because management could not afford him. This information was told to me the Sunday previous, but no mention of the acquisition of Jim Graves was made, I only found this out on the Saturday when he played at Bracknell. We can't afford Rob Morris - is Jim Graves playing for us for nothing?? This decision will stand for the start of next season hoping to make enough to help form a sensible experienced outfit. I thank all members who attended the meeting and am sure that those who could not make it would have been in agreement with their fellow supporters, I will strive to do my best for the Lee Valley Lions as always but I must always put the majority wishes of our members first and foremost. Well let's hope things start to improve and we can all work towards a winning Lions team again!
